I can't believe it has been two years that I have been here in Santa Lucia already! In some ways, it seems I have been here an eternity, and in others, it seems that I just got here. I am so thankful for the opportunities the Lord gives me to serve Him each and every day.

March found me in the States for two weeks due to the death of an uncle. Even though it was a hard time saying good-bye, we rejoice that we will see him again one day. I was also blessed to see cousins that I haven't seen in many years. It was good to catch up with family and friends during that time.

During Semana Santa (Easter Week), I was invited to go with a family to Nicaragua to visit their family. During that time, we had the opportunity to visit, but also, we had the opportunity to witness and evangelize in a very Catholic town. Many souls received the seed of the Gospel. Pray for the increase.

During the first week of April, I had the opportunity to host my first official group here in Santa Lucia. Thank you to Pastor Eric Hice for heading up this group and coming to help in the ministry. Your time here was a blessing to all of us.

This weekend our church choir will have the opportunity to present a program entitled "The King of Glory." Our choir may be small, but they have put a lot of work into this program. We are praying for God to receive the glory.

The school ministry continues to progress forward. Please pray with me for more laborers. A few of the children have begun coming to the Bible club at the church on Wednesday night. Please pray for their salvation. Speaking of Bible clubs, this year we have four clubs each week, two of which have been turned over to other leaders, and the other two I am currently running whilst training nationals to take them over, Lord willing, by the end of this year. Please especially pray for the club in la 30 de noviembre as it is a very hard area to work in. People know we are there, but don't want to come to the Bible studies or the club. The first week, we had 16 children. Now we average about eight each week. I know these children are precious in God's sight and am praying for their salvation.
